**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REVISED CODE OR COMPOSITE INDEX OF  
ORDINANCES, SUPERSEDING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the City of Manor Creek, Kentucky, adopts a revised code or composite index of ordinances for the City as a new and original comprehensive ordinance, superseding all ordinances of the city in conflict therewith, and

WHEREAS, a copy of such code or composite index shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk, maintained in accordance with the guidelines of the Kentucky Department for Local Government or its successor and available as part of the public records of the city.
